

CAW Local 229 Bursary

CAW Local 229 is funding four (4) bursaries of \$500 which will be awarded to sons/daughters of CAW Local 229 Members who have graduated in 2010 and are entering their first year of post secondary education. Members must be in good standing, present or deceased.

These awards will be given as follows:

- 2 bursaries to graduates of the Public Schools Board
- 2 bursaries to graduates of the Catholic District School Board

The student must be graduating from a secondary program proceeding to advanced education in a Canadian institution. This is an entrance bursary and is not renewable for a student entering his/her second year of studies.

The successful applicants will be required to submit documentation indicating acceptance at a Canadian Institution as well as proof of registration before the presentation of the bursary.

Submissions will include:

- official application form
- applicant's transcript/record of marks, most current record, mid term report is acceptable
- letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member
- essay as listed on the application form

The selection of applicants will be made by the CAW Local 229 Selection Committee. The award decision will be the sole responsibility of the CAW Local 229 Selection committee and their decision is final. By completing and signing the application you give CAW Local 229 permission to reproduce your essay and name for promotion purposes in their newsletter, web site, promotional displays, and advertising material.
